Call to Order

Review and Discuss Preliminary Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Proposed Budget

Mr. Miller distributed and reviewed the preliminary Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Proposed Budget for the Board. He reviewed the steps of the budget process. Mr. Miller reviewed the line items of the budget for the Board. Discussion ensued regarding the proposed budget. Mr. Miller stated that the grand total for the proposed Fiscal Year 2009/2010 budget was \$546,044 with a 5% total reduction of \$28,664. Mr. Miller reviewed the capital improvement projects. Discussion ensued regarding the capital improvement projects.

Mr. Schmidt asked if the District had another newspaper media that could be utilized for advertising if the current provider went out of business.
