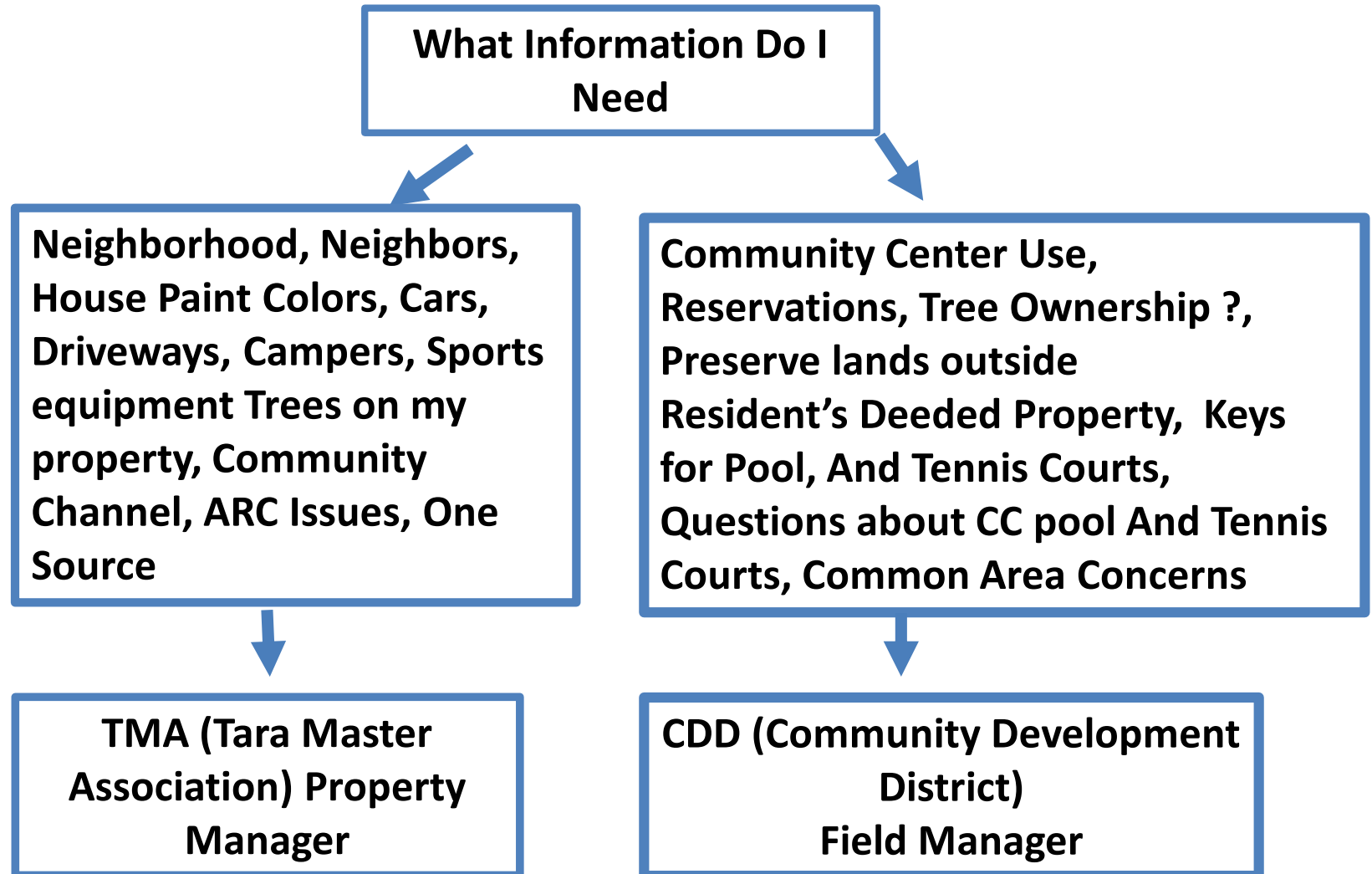


Decision Tree to Information TMA or CDD

Things you should know about the Cutting of Trees and Foliage out side of your property.

The CDD has no control or authority to deal with trees, foliage, Brazilian Pepper, potato plants etc., outside the property it maintains or owns. The trimming of trees on residential properties hanging over Manatee County Roads are the responsibility or come under authority of the resident owning the tree, Manatee County and the TMA ARC.

Things you should know about the Cutting of Trees and Foliage out side of your property.

Trees that hang over a neighbors property and the tree is owned by the neighbor once again do not come under the control of the CDD. These questions are between the neighbors and the TMA ARC.

Trees that are on CDD Property, or Property maintained under easement by the CDD are a responsibility of the CDD. Residents wishing to trim these trees should contact the CDD Field Manager.
